Hello,
Thank you for your interest in Tesla Time!

If you have downloaded the archived “zip file” from our website, you will need to first uncompress the files first.

On a Mac you can just double-click the zip file.

On a Windows PC, you should double-click the zip file, then look for the link on the left bar that says “Extract these files” (or similar) and follow the wizard.

Once the files have been uncompressed - you or your tech staff can duplicate those files to use on multiple computers, or you can create CDs if you’d like. You can also post the files on a school server and give each student a link to it.

To run the program:

1. Unzip the files as described above.
2. Make sure your headphones or speakers are on and working (***Note:** If multiple computers will be running the program at once, I highly recommend headphones for all students).
3. Copy the files to the local hard drive of your computer
4. Double-click the file “start_here.html” to begin.
5. Click which program you want to run:
 - a. *Tesla Time’s Electrical Adventure* – a complete program that explores electricity.
 - b. *Tesla II – Magnetism* – a short lesson and single puzzle involving magnetism.

Info for the person installing the program:

This program requires a recent version of Flash Player, otherwise some sections of video will not appear. If you’d like to test to see if your version can handle this program, open the folder “publish” and then open the file “index.html”. This will take you through a very short test to determine if you need to upgrade your Flash Player, and give you a link to do so.
